### US FIGURE SKATING CLASS STRUCTURE

(All one hour sessions include ½ hour group lesson and ½ hour practice time)

**Snowplow Sam 1-3** (Ages 3 to 5) This class is designed to help preschool-age children develop preliminary coordination & strength necessary to maneuver on skates.

**Basic Skills 1-8** (Ages 6 to 16) The “Basic Skills” are the fundamentals of the sport. These eight levels of the program introduce the fundamental moves to school aged children. Upon completion of Basic 1-8 levels, skaters can advance to more specialized areas of skating – free skating, dance, synchronized, and pairs.

**Freestyle 1-6** (Ages 6 to 16) The Freestyle curriculum is designed for the more advanced level skater. Skaters must have passed Basic 8 in order to enroll in Freestyle 1. Elements introduced in freestyle levels include various jumps, spins and different use of edges. **Private lessons are recommended for this advanced level skater.**

**Adult 1-4** (Ages 16 & Up) These classes are designed for the adult skaters to learn at their own pace. Elements covered are forward and backward skating, crossovers, stopping and various use of edges.

## QUESTION & ANSWER

Do you have a question? Please ask. We are here to help.

Q: Is there a charge for skate rental?

A: Yes. Skates are available for \$2 per pair, per class, per skater at the Skate Rental Desk. Helmets are \$2 per helmet, per class, per skater. Payment for the skate and helmet rental is completed at the rink's front desk. A receipt must be shown to the Skate Rental Desk for receipt of skates and/or helmet.

Q: Should my skater wear a helmet?

A: Helmets are required for all skaters (ages 6 and under) enrolled in Snow Plow Sam and Basic Skills. Bicycle helmets may be used.

Q: What type of clothing is suitable for my skater?

A: Dress your skater in warm, comfortable clothing which gives the skater the freedom to move. Soft, warm socks are recommended for the boots along with gloves (with fingers) for keeping hands warm.
